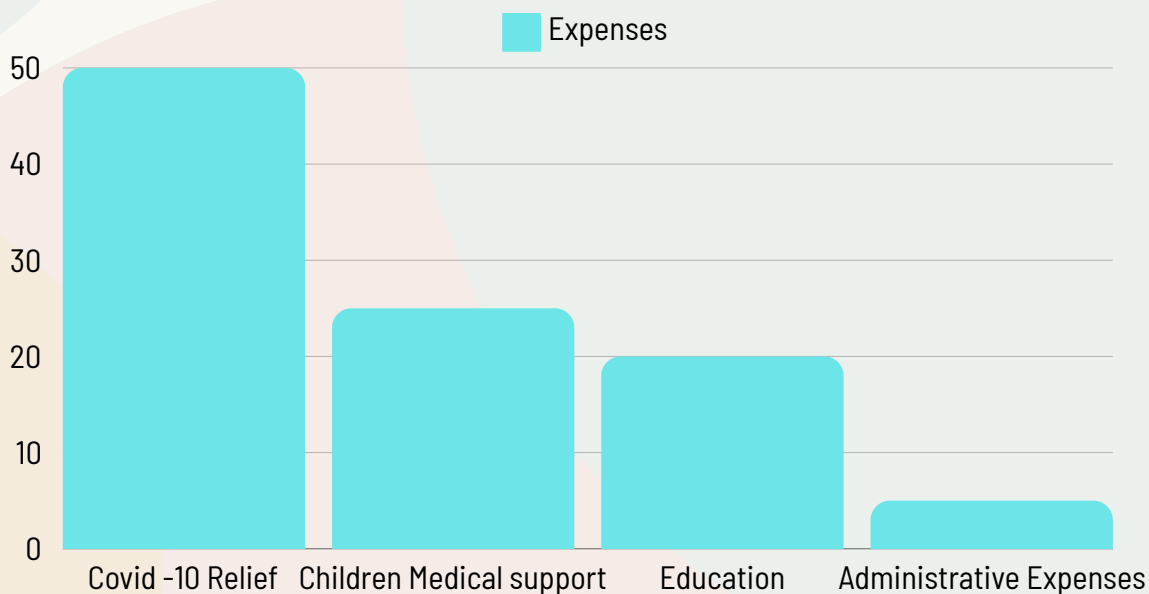
Financial Overview


